

# McPHERRON WETLAND MITIGATION PROJECT

*Chest Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania*

BluAcres, LLC (BluAcres) provided technical services for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on a wetland mitigation project in north central Pennsylvania. The McPherron wetland mitigation project in Clearfield County was proposed by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation as an advanced compensation site for wetlands anticipated to be impacted on a nearby bridge replacement project.

The McPherron wetland mitigation consisted of the restoration of two acres of scrub/shrub and emergent wetlands.

BluAcres was subcontracted by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and provided the following technical services on the McPherron wetland mitigation project:

- Construction staking and layout of the project.
- Construction Management and Coordination of the Construction Phase of the Project.

- Quality Assurance Inspection.
- As-Built survey and preparation of post-construction “as-built” drawings.

The construction phase of the McPherron wetland mitigation project was completed in December 2007.
